
## **Bartlett Lodge is Unique**

A short boat ride from Cache Lake landing, a 20ft motorized freighter canoe shuttles guests to our secluded side of the lake. Our water access only private accommodations anticipate your arrival boasting unsurpassed Canadian wilderness in the heart of Algonquin Park. Canoeing, kayaking, swimming, hiking, biking, paddleboats and the peace of nature awaits you and your guests.

## **Cottages and Cabins**

To reserve the full resort, a minimum of 38 adults are required. We happily accept groups of less than 38 adults with the understanding that exclusivity of the resort isn't provided.

#### Starting from the dining room building

<u>Jack Pine</u>: This lovely two-bedroom cottage has a king-size bed, two single beds and a modern four-piece bathroom. Guests can enjoy a wonderful view - and a wood fire! - from the large sitting room or the screened-in porch.

**Black Spruce**: Black Spruce is a unique one-bedroom cabin with a king-size bed, comfortable lower-level living room, bathroom and screened-in porch.

<u>Northern River</u>: At the highest point on the property, this cabin includes a large living room with huge picture windows, a sofa bed and a propane stove which make this cozy cabin one of our most popular. The cabin includes one bedroom with a king-size bed, one bedroom with two single beds and a four-piece bathroom.

<u>Wildflowers</u>: Perched on the shore of Cache Lake, this cabin features a large screened-in porch which spans the entire front of the cabin. It includes a king-size bed and three-piece bathroom. This cozy one-bedroom cabin is a guest favourite.

<u>Woodland Waterfall</u>: This shoreside one-bedroom cabin has a large screened-in porch, king-size bed and new bathroom. Woodland Waterfall offers arguably the best views of the lake with no obstructions. Go to sleep with the sound of the waves rippling against the shore or listen to the loons and the evening sounds of Algonquin.

<u>Sunrise</u>: This log cabin is our environmental masterpiece; solar-powered and energy self-sufficient. It has a large bed/sitting room with a king-size bed, sitting area and wood stove. The second bedroom has bunk beds with a double bed as the bottom bunk. There is a four-piece bathroom and screened-in porch.

<u>Silver Birches</u>: Silver Birches is a shoreside log cabin with a screened-in porch overlooking Cache Lake. This cabin includes a large bed/sitting room with a king-size bed, a second bedroom with a set of single bunk beds for the kids and a four-piece bathroom.

<u>Northern Lake</u>: Located right on the shoreline, this cabin has a cozy sitting area with a glass-front wood burning stove. The main bedroom has a king-size bed with access to the bathroom and the second bedroom has 2 single beds. Guests can enjoy the panoramic view of Cache Lake from the log-frame screened-in porch.

<u>West Wind</u>: The screened-in porch and cozy living room with a wood stove make Westwind one of our most popular cabins. Two of the bedrooms have king-size beds and the third has two single beds.

<u>Deil Ma Care</u>: Originally built in 1898, Deil Ma Care is our oldest and most historic cabin. Located at the shoreline, this piece of Algonquin history has two bedrooms with king size beds, a third bedroom with two single beds, a living room and a large screened-in porch which directly overlooks Cache Lake.

**Summer Day**: This one-bedroom log cabin is located at the quiet end of our shoreline. Summer Day has all the character you would expect of a log cabin and includes a king-size bed, four-piece bathroom, inside sitting area, and large screened-in porch.

**Spring Ice**: Built from squared Hemlock log, and renovated in the fall of 2020, this one-bedroom cabin has a bed/sitting room with a king-size bed and a four-piece bathroom, and brand-new wood burning fireplace. Spring Ice is located on the quietest part of the Lodge property and offers the most privacy of any unit.

<u>AY Jackson</u>: This suite is part of our 100-year old log building which was reconstructed in 2012. It contains a king size bed, a three-piece bathroom, sitting area, small bar fridge and screened porch facing a quiet bay on Cache Lake.

<u>Lawren Harris</u>: This suite is part of our 100-year old log building which was reconstructed in 2012. It contains a king size bed, a three-piece bathroom, sitting area, small bar fridge and screened porch facing a quiet bay on Cache Lake. Lawren Harris is connected to Isabel's Lounge, one of our main guest lounges accessible to all guests.

<u>Guides Tent</u>: Featuring a wooden frame and canvas roof and walls, our "Glamping" tents are our most unique experience. Each tent is fully-furnished with a king-size bed, inside seating area and a deck for warm summer evenings. Battery operated lamps provide safe soft lighting. A new private washroom building with showers is located just a few steps away. Guides Tent is further back on our property offering more privacy.

<u>Thomson Tent</u>: Featuring a wooden frame and canvas roof and walls, our "Glamping" tents are our most unique experience. Each tent is fully-furnished with a king-size bed, inside seating area and a deck for warm summer evenings. Battery operated lamps provide safe soft lighting. A new private washroom building with showers is located just a few steps away. Thomson Tent is located right on the shoreline of our side bay.

## **Dining Room: Casual Elegance**



Our rates include a 4-course dinner each evening and full breakfast in the morning. Our chef is happy to work with the couple to create a special menu for the wedding night dinner. Choose from various locally conscious and sustainable dishes that our Chef has to offer. The dinner menu begins with a charcuterie board for each table, followed by an appetizer, entrée and dessert of your guests choosing.

At breakfast, we offer a buffet of fresh baked goods, cereals, as well as fruit and cheese platters. Guests can order an item from the hot menu, the main part of the breakfast.

When you

reserve the entire resort, the mealtimes are your discretion. If you opt for a smaller wedding and there are guests at the lodge who are not part of your group, then our set meals times will be in place; 6pm or 8pm for dinner and breakfast from 8am-9:30am.





There are additional food options that can be offered throughout your visit. We are happy to offer hors d'oeuvres during cocktail hour, a late-night snack between 10pm-11pm and lunch by either a buffet or packed style selection. Each additional food option is a per person rate and prices vary based on your selection.

A dining room fee is added to the invoice for exclusive use of the main dining room. Please see our pricing chart below to determine the rate by dates. This amount would be in place to cover the cost of maintenance and cleaning.

Our dining room can accommodate up to 50 guests and is not licensed for alcohol. You are responsible to acquire the Special Occasions Permit that is required to serve your guests and then you may bring your own wine, beer, or spirits. Glassware will be provided. You can purchase the permit through the Alcohol Gaming Commission of Ontario.




### The Finer Details

Choose one of our three docks with a scenic view of Cache Lake in the background for your ceremony and greeting of guests. We can also offer you our beautiful guest lounge, Isabel's Cabin, if the weather is not suitable for an outdoor setting.

Our check in time is 3:00 PM. If your guests arrive early and their cabin is not available, we invite them to enjoy the Park, relax in our lounge, or sit on one of our docks until the cabin is ready. The check-out time for departing guests is 11 AM.

Guests of the lodge will be provided with a park permit which will allow them access to the many walking trails of the Park. During the time spent at the lodge guests can experience the Algonquin Park Visitor Centre, the Logging Museum, and the Algonquin Art Gallery. Guests can enjoy the use of the canoes, kayaks, paddleboats, and stand-up paddle boards (included in the rate) exploring the many bays and inlets of Cache Lake. We have mountain bikes available for those who wish to take on the challenge of the biking trails of Algonquin Park.



#### **Contractual Details**

To confirm a booking reservation, we require a deposit of 10% of the total invoice. The deposit can be paid by credit card or cheque. The deposit is entirely refundable if a cancellation is made with at least 60 days' notice of the date of the reservation. The deposit becomes nonrefundable thereafter. The rate quoted only applies if all the cabins are reserved and confirmed, and there have been no cancellations. The minimum number of guests required when booking the entire resort is 38; all quotes are based on this number (see rate calendar below). Any additional guests above the minimum required number will be charged the per person rate per night agreed upon, plus all applicable taxes and gratuities. Groups that do not meet the minimum of 38 adults, are welcome to inquire about a booking; however, a minimum charge would still apply.
